OK. I'll do that.

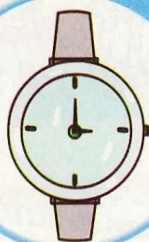
Li Hua! Is this

And theirs is not ours, it's yours.





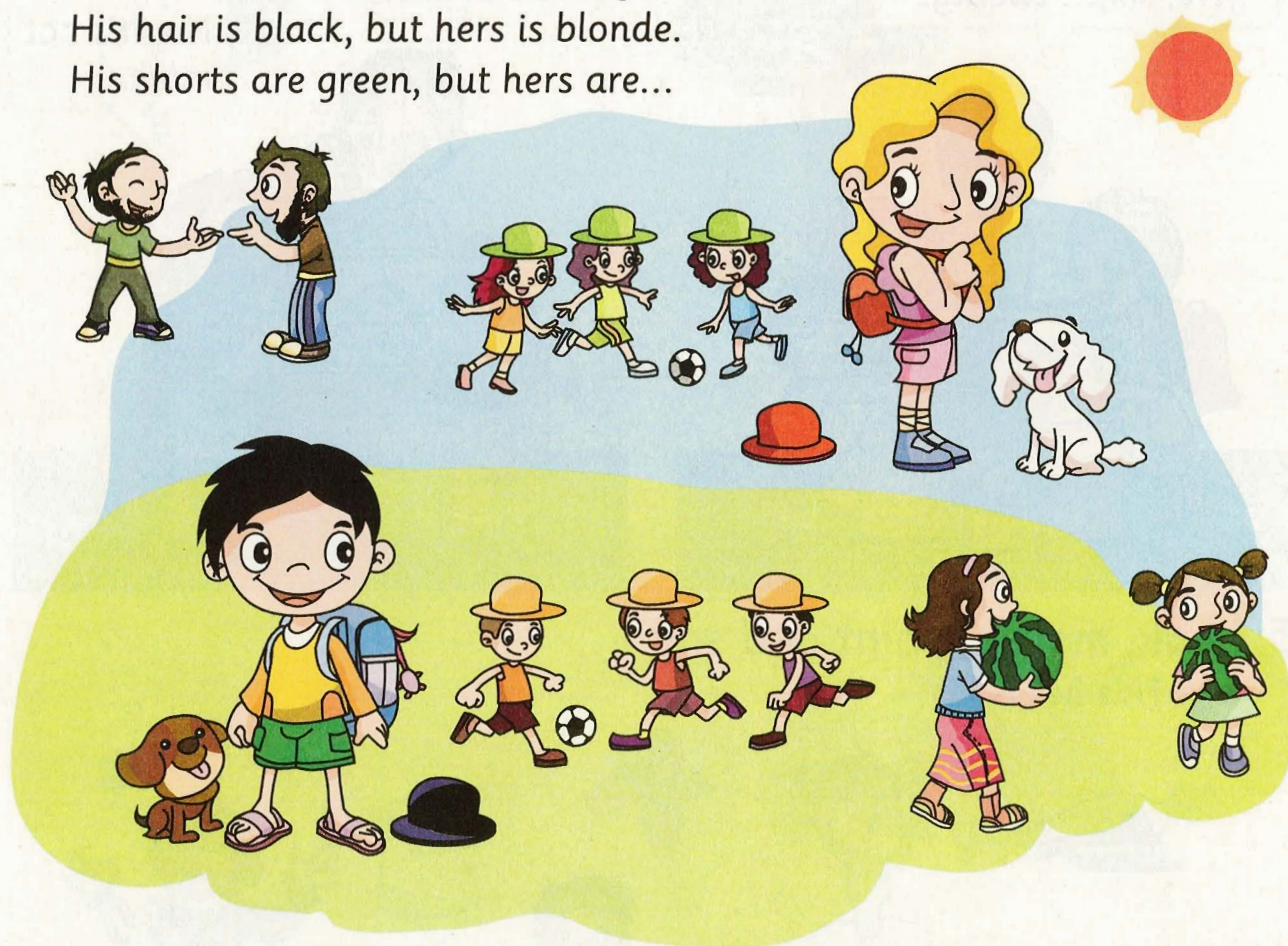

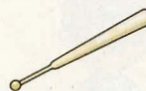
